3. What do you think about Jesus' response to Mary and Martha when they express their frustration to him?
4. Read v. 24-26 together. What is the difference between knowing the "Sunday school answer" and truly believing it? What makes that so hard?
5. What is an area of your life that is dead that you need Jesus to make alive? Be willing to be honest and to think about specific struggles with sin, areas of brokenness, and other effects of the fall.
6. What would those same areas of your life look like if they were made "alive, alive" in Christ?
7. Jesus gives you the power to do all that he calls you to. How might you live differently if you really believed that?
