Question 5: Is there more than one God?

Answer: There is only one, the living and true God.

Question 6: How many persons are in the one God?

Answer: Three persons are in the one God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are one God, the same in substance and equal in power and glory.

3. Why does it matter that God's second call of Jonah is so similar to the first? What does that teach us about God?

5. What is an area of your life where you hope to be offered a chance to get "back in the game"?
6. What would it look like for you to "run the next play"? In other words, what is a small, next step of obedience that God might be calling you to?
